Program participants are considered year-round students of Texas Ballet Theater School.

Summary

Texas Ballet Theater (TBT) seeks to fill the position of **CityDance Ballet Instructor – Dallas or Fort Worth** for the school year. This individual will instruct classes in TBT's CityDance and Dance Extension Programs. TBT employs Community Enrichment ballet instructors to be enthusiastic ambassadors for the art form and professional representatives of the organization. Our CityDance curriculum introduces ballet to young students across the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex, primarily 1st – 4th grades, in Title I schools and community organizations. The Dance Extension

Program curriculum matches that of Texas Ballet Theater School and is delivered to students in host sites primarily in Dallas and Tarrant Counties. Instructor must have access to reliable transportation. Community Enrichment Instructors report to the Educational Programs Manager.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Follow CityDance curriculum to teach beginning ballet for up to 40 students for 1-hour class sessions
- Follow Texas Ballet Theater School curriculum for appropriate class level for up to 15 Dance Extension Program students for 1-hour class sessions
- Consistent availability during the hours of 3:00pm – 4:30pm for at least one day each week
- Ability to teach either in Dallas County or Tarrant County and its immediate surrounding areas, including Arlington, Grand Prairie, Mansfield, and more
- Attend all scheduled teacher meetings as requested
- Provide positive and healthy support for students, as a leader and a mentor
- Maintain a positive, disciplined environment for the students during their ballet class
