Our Adaptive Dance program introduces ballet to young students across the Dallas- Fort Worth Metroplex, primarily 4-8 year olds diagnosed with Down syndrome or similar diagnoses. This program is done in collaboration with Cook Children's. Instructor must have access to reliable transportation. Adaptive Dance Instructors report to the Educational Programs Manager.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Follow adaptive dance curriculum to teach beginning ballet and creative movement to 4-8 year olds.
- Consistent availability weekly for an agreed-upon class time for this program.
- Ability to teach at either Texas Ballet Theater School's Fort Worth or Dallas locations.
- Attend all scheduled teacher meetings as requested.
- Provide positive and healthy support for students, as a leader and a mentor.
- Maintain a positive, disciplined environment for the students during their ballet class.
- Willingness to continue education and training in order to better assist and provide access to this population.
